F2010-02 Child's top

Size 92 / 98 / 104 to fit age 2 / 3 / 4

Actual measurements:

Chest	64 / 68 / 72
Length	37 / 39 / 41

Materials:

LANG YARNS GOLF (pure cotton) 200 / 250 / 250g = 4 / 5 / 5 balls white 163.0001, and 50g = 1 ball each of pink 163.0009, yellow 163.0014 and green 163.0017.

LANG YARNS / ADDI knitting needles size 2.5 mm, 3 mm and 3.5 mm. 3 buttons

Pattern I: 3 mm needles: k1, p1 rib

Pattern II: 3.5 mm needles: stocking stitch = RS k, WS p

Pattern III: 3.5 mm needles: lace pattern according to the chart: right side only shown, work all WS row sts as they appear. Rep. rows 1 – 16.

Tension: over Pattern II, using size 3.5 mm needles: 25 sts x 30 rows = 10 x 10 cm

Back: Using 2.5mm needles and the Italian cast on method, cast on 42 / 45 / 48 sts in green = 82 / 88 / 94 sts after 4 rows. Continue in Pattern I, working 4 rows in green followed by 4 rows in yellow, then pink and then white. Change to Pattern II and continue in white.

Armholes: 22 / 23 / 24 cm from cast on edge (measured hanging) cast off at either end of every second row: 1x3 sts, 1x2 sts and 4x1 st = 64 / 70 / 76 sts. **Shoulders:** when armholes measure 14 / 15 / 16 cm cast off at each end of every second row: 1x7 sts + 1x8 sts / 2x8 sts / 2x9 sts and **at the same time for the neck:** at the beginning of the shoulder shaping cast off the centre 28 / 32 / 34 sts and on either side a further 1x3 sts.

Front: Knit as for back. **Front opening:** When beginning armhole shaping also cast off the centre 4 sts and continue the two sides separately. **Neckline:** When front opening measures 10 / 11 / 11 cm cast off on the neck edge every other row as follows: 1x5 / 7 / 7 sts, 1x4 sts, 1x2 sts and 4x / 5x / 5x 1 st. **Shape shoulders** in the same way as for back.

Sleeves: Using 2.5 mm needles and the Italian cast on method, cast on 32 / 34 / 34 sts in green = 62 / 66 / 66 sts after 4 rows. Continue in Pattern I, working 4 rows in green, 4 rows pink, 4 rows white.

Continue in pattern III according to chart, then increasing 1 st at each end of every 4th row 3 times = 68 / 72 / 72 sts. **Shape top of sleeve:** When sleeve measures 10 cm (measured hanging) cast off at each end of every 2nd row: 1x3 sts, 1x / 2x / 2x2 sts, 8x1 st, 2x4 sts, and 1x3 sts. Cast off the remaining stitches loosely.

Pockets (x2): Cast on 20 sts in green. Knit Pattern III according to chart. 7.5 cm from cast on knit 4 rows yellow in Pattern I. Cast off using Italian cast off method.

Finishing: Close seams. Attach pockets approximately 2 cm above rib edge and 4 cm from the side seams.

Front button band: pick up approx. 29 / 31 / 31 sts in yellow along side of right front opening from below neck edge to cast off at centre front. Work in Pattern I, beginning (WS) with 1 edge st, p1, k1 and ending in reverse. Work 3 rows yellow, then continue in green and work **2 buttonholes** as follows: work 6 sts, cast off 2 sts by passing sts over without using working yarn and cast on 2 sts in their place, repeat buttonhole after a further 11 / 13 / 13 sts, continue to end of row. After 6 rows, cast off using Italian method. Make left button band in the same way, omitting buttonholes. Sew lower end of the buttonhole band to the cast off sts of the centre front and the lower end of the button band to the back of this. **Neck:** with yellow yarn pick up approx. 99 / 103 / 107 sts from around the neck, including the top of the button bands (= back 39 / 41 / 41 sts, each front 30 / 31 / 33 sts) and knit in Pattern I, beginning (WS) with 1 edge st, k1, p1 and ending in reverse. Then continue in green, at the same time making one **buttonhole** as follows: work 3 sts, cast off 2 sts by passing over sts without using working yarn and cast on 2 sts in their place, work to end of row. After 3 rows in green cast off using the Italian method.

Set in sleeves. Sew on buttons.
